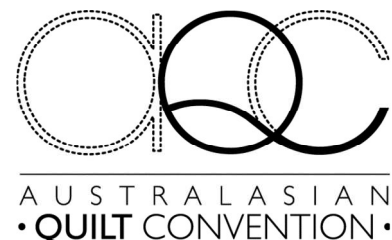


CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Advanced Quilting Techniques

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount required and place it in an envelope with your name and the tutor's name on the front. This is to be given to the tutor before commencement of the class.

You must bring along the following:

- Dark** coloured homespun, like black or navy Plains no prints, (Approx 1.5 metres)
- Wadding wool/polyester blend, or wool/cotton or 100% polyester **MUST** have a scrim. (approx 1.5 metre)

Out of these please Cut 8 wadding and 8 fabric into 35 x50 cm rectangles (we are not using backing fabric) lightly pin these together.

- 3 reels (more if you have them) of Thread: 100% cotton 40 or 50 weight variegated threads contrast colour to fabric, brands like Signature, YLI or King Tut.
- Mettler Polysheen variegated colours 9937, 9971, 9914, 9405. Lots of colours please.(optional extra)
- 1 reel of 100% cotton 50 weight Gutermann thread to match colour of fabric for bobbin.
- Metallic threads like Ricky Tims razzle dazzle, Signature laserbrite, thick metallic's, or threads that you would never fit through a needle and usually break difficult threads that you have at home.
- Sewing machine needles quilting size sharp 80 and 90, metallics
- Scissors and usual sewing needs
- F or 2B pencil
- Pen and 12 sheets of A4 paper or small exercise book for drawing patterns on
- Quilt pounce if you have one with Blue or white chalk please
- Any quilting feather stencils that you have at home that you would like to try
- Small piece of scrap fabric and wadding pinned together to test tensions and to warm up quilting on approx 30cm square
- One pair Ansell HI Flex gloves \$5.00 from supermarkets.

Sewing Machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant will be available in class to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine.

If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine, you may. Ensure it is well maintained and that you also bring the instruction manual and accessories, and bring your extension table, darning foot, free motion foot [if you have a Bernina machine (# 29) (clear foot) and #24 foot and BSR open toe foot (BSR option for students); straight stitch plate and standard plate. Three bobbins. Multi spool holder if possible.

- ✓ We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.
- ✓ Please make sure you label everything with your name.
