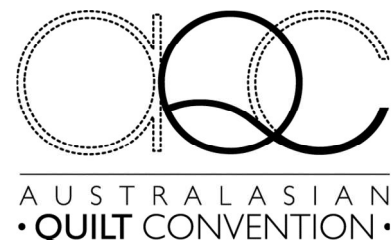


CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **New York Beauty/Mariners Compass**

New York Beauty

Foundation piecing is used in this class to achieve accurate points for this traditional pattern. It can be made using just two fabrics such as blue and white as many of the old quilts were done or you can give a more contemporary look by using a variety of fabrics. Patterns will be provided for 5, 7 and 9 points in different size blocks.

Mariner's Compass 28" circle 16 or 32 points

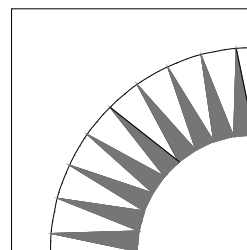
Have you always wanted to make a Mariner's Compass Block but been put off by those fine points. Then join this class and learn the paper foundation method. The compass can be made with either 16 or 32 points and patterns will be supplied to create a flying geese border circle.

Sewing Machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant will be available in class to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine.

If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine, you may. Ensure it is well maintained and that you also bring the instruction manual and accessories, and bring your open-toed foot, or clear plastic foot.

- ✓ We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.
- ✓ Please make sure you label everything with your name.

NEW YORK BEAUTY

This is a very old pattern with a new way to sew it using papers to accurately achieve those fine points. It can be sewn using just two fabrics such as blue and white, red and white etc. as many of the old quilts were done or you can give a more contemporary look by using a variety of fabrics. The blocks can be placed in many different ways to create different patterns. Patterns will be provided for 5, 7 and 9 points and pattern for points on inner circle.

Requirements

Ruler, rotary cutter and cutting board.

A camera to record other ideas.

Paper scissors, 20 sheets of A4 paper, typing or computer

Fabric for a two colour quilt (Blue and white quilt)

Background 3 m

Contrast 1 m

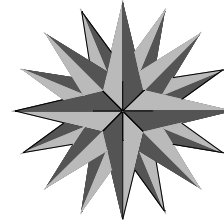
This is sufficient for 16 10" blocks.

You can make the small quarter circle and also the large outer segment from a different fabric if you wish.

Fabric for multi coloured quilt (Bright colour sample)

In the bright quilt sample lots of different fabrics were used, plain, striped and busy fabrics. Bring a selection in the colours you like. The largest pieces for the background are 10" squares. For the 9 point sections strips are cut 4½" x 1½" for the points and for the background 4½" x 1¾."

This is not a quick "quilt in a day", but rather a technique for accurately machine piecing this block. Rather than making 16 blocks, you may prefer to bring scrap fabric for 4 blocks which is enough for a large cushion.

TRUE MARINER'S COMPASS

28" - 16 or 32 Points

Have you always wanted to make a Mariner's Compass Block but been put off by those fine points? Then join this workshop and learn the paper foundation method. The compass can be a wall hanging or the centre piece for a medallion quilt.

This is not a "quilt in a day" class but a technique to accurately achieve the fine points in these stunning quilts. Handout will include pattern for circle of flying geese.

Requirements

Cutting board, ruler and cutter
10 pages of A3 paper (can be 2 A4 taped together)
Paper scissors
A camera to record other ideas

Fabric requirements will depend on how many different fabrics you use. Plain and small print fabric are best for the fine points. Plain or patterned fabric work well as a background and can be either light or dark.

In the sample quilt two shades of each colour were used, yellow, orange, green, blue, purple and red. The quilt also looks great using just background and all the points in one colour say a light and a dark blue.

Fabric requirements for sample quilt.

Yellow/Orange 20cm two shades of each (light and dark of yellow and orange)
If you wish to cut from your scraps each piece is 15" x 4½"
e.g. 2 light yellow - 2 dark yellow 2 light orange - 2 dark orange
Green/Blue 20cm two shades of each (light and dark of blue and green)
If you wish to cut from your scraps each piece is 11" x 3¼"
Purple/Red 10cm two shades of each (light and dark of purple and red)
If you wish to cut from your scraps each piece is 9½" x 2"

If using two shades of one colour 50cm of each shade.

Background 2.5m
