

# CLASS REQUIREMENTS

## You must bring along the following:

- Pen, pencil, eraser, sticky tape, black medium felt tipped marker (e.g. Sharpie)
- Large sheet of white paper – needs to be at least as big as proposed quilt size (can join)
- Pins – lots of straight pins
- 2 metre of non-iron Tear – away (available from the tutor)
- 2 metres of Freezer paper
- 1 metre of fusible web - e.g. Steam a Seam, Wonder Under, Vliesofix
- Nylon thread – YLI Wonder Invisible thread or monopoly recommended
- Thread to blend with fabrics
- Machine needles size 60, and size 70 and topstitch machine needles size 90
- Scissors (fabric and paper), quick unpick.
- Rotary cutter
- Ruler and small cutting board

## Fabrics

Bring a range of fabrics that have a variation in pattern and value. A suggestion is to choose two or three colors that work well together and then select fabrics making sure you include some lights, mediums and darks. Make sure you include a variety of patterns and also some plainer fabrics. Suitable hand dyed fabrics will be available in the class room.

**Sewing Machines** will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant will be available in class to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine.

**If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may. Ensure it is well maintained and that you also bring the instruction manual and accessories, and bring your **darning foot is essential and an open toed embroidery foot would be very useful.**

- ✓ We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.
- ✓ Please make sure you label everything with your name.
