## You must bring along the following:

From Julie:

“This workshop involves fun, open ended art and design exercises that lend themselves in various ways to creating imagery for textiles and quilting. You need a variety of items most of which can be found at home, newsagency, hardware or charity shop. I have given guidelines for amounts of things only to help prevent worrying or over buying. We will swap bits and pieces too, so don't worry if you are unable to find everything.”

- A3 / A4 Sketchbook
- Tracing paper
- Drawing tools; lead pencil, eraser, ruler
- Black felt tip pen
- Coloured pencils
- Colours to play with; could be coloured markers or paint set; acrylic or watercolours and small paintbrushes
- Glue stick
- Scissors; paper
- 2 - 4 different picture types. Magazines eg national geographic, house & garden, cooking, Woman's day, tourist brochures, junk mail, catalogues. [to cut up]
- Coloured paper A4 or smaller 10 – 20 bits; variety of colours and textures.
- Stencil knife or stanley knife
- Cutting mat
- Plus small amounts of some of the following items
- Interesting scraps of papers [envelope size or smaller]....foil, glitz, handmade, wallpaper, paint chart, doily, serviette, tissue box, cereal box, computer paper, ribbon

✓ We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.

✓ Please make sure you label everything with your name.
