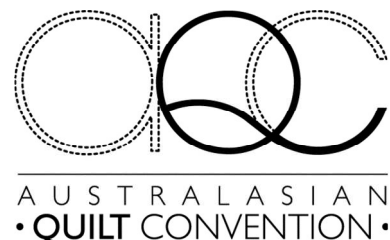


CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **Yes, you can Free Motion Quilt**

Fee: Professionally printed notes are provided for this class at a cost of \$10.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount required and place it in an envelope with your name and the tutor's name on the front. This is to be given to the tutor before commencement of the class.

You must bring along the following:

- 8 x pieces of black or navy 100% homespun cut into rectangles 50 x 70 cm **or** 20x 28 inches these will make four samples. Plains no prints.
- 4 x pieces of wadding, wool/polyester blend or cotton/wool same size as above no 100% cotton wadding please
- ❖ **Please pin these samples with safety pins no more than 3 inches apart ready to quilt = 4 small quilts**
- 3 reels of 100% cotton Variegated thread either 40 or 50 weight nice bright colours please (more reels if you have them)
- 1 reel x 50 weight 100% cotton Gutermann thread to match the fabric for bobbin
- 2 reels of Polysheen variegated, 100% polyester variegated (optional extra looks great) colours 9971, 9914, 9937, 9405. are beautiful
- Sewing machine needles size sharp 80 and 90, metallics
- Scissors
- 2B pencil , pen and 12 sheets of A4 paper or small exercise book for drawing patterns
- Scrap fabric 30 x30 cm square approx and wadding pinned together to test tensions and to warm up quilting on
- Quilting gloves or I prefer Ansell HI Flex gloves \$5.00 from supermarkets.

Please bring along quilts that you want to quilt in the future for advice from Deborah

Sewing Machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant will be available in class to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine.

If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine, you may. Ensure it is well maintained and that you also bring the instruction manual and accessories, and bring your extension table, darning foot, free motion foot [if you have a Bernina machine (# 29) (clear foot) and #24 foot and BSR open toe foot (BSR optional for students); straight stitch plate and standard plate. Three bobbins. Multi spool holder if possible.

- ✓ We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.
- ✓ Please make sure you label everything with your name.
