

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

You must bring along the following:

Basic supply list

- Rotary cutter, extra blade and mat,
- Ruler
- Fabric scissors
- Seam ripper
- 30 or more pins or safety pins
- Small trash bag.

Fabric

- Silk scraps and leftover silk fabric (bring different weight of silk fabric in white or any colour, old silk fabric from a blouse or shirt is fine, too)
- Backing: 40cm x 40cm (cotton, silk, any kind)
- Batting: 35cm x 35cm (polyester, cotton, silk any kind)
- For finishing edge: 50cm x 25cm (any kind)
- Black soft tulle: 40cm x 40cm x 2 pieces

Threads & needles

- 40wt. 50wt. polyester, rayon, silk quilting or embroidery threads
- Monofilament invisible threads
- Bobbin threads
- Needles for machine quilting and metallic threads(75/11, 90/14, metafile)

Other

- 3 or more photos of naturescapes, a roll of paper towel, 3 paper plates, old towel, plastic gloves

Kit fee: A kit is provided for this class at a cost of **\$20**.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your name and the tutor's and class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

Kit consists of:

- Silk dye, silk fibres, yarns, ribbons

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own.

A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual and accessories.

- Also **bring your free motion zigzag foot, darning foot or equivalent and extra bobbins**,

Suggestions:

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
