

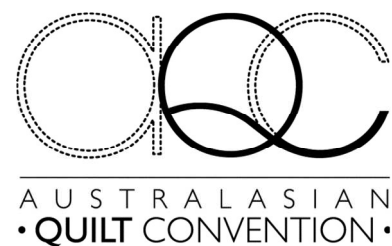
## CLASS REQUIREMENTS

### You must bring along the following:

(Unless otherwise noted measurements are across the width of the fabric)

- Background:** 3.2 metres cream for all blocks including border rectangles
- Sashings:** 50cm black
- Appliqué:** 20 - 30cm pieces (by width of fabric) or fat eighths of the following shades:
  - 3 blues (light, medium and dark)
  - 3 browns (light, medium and dark)
  - 2 greens (medium and dark)
  - 2 mustard yellows (medium and dark)
  - 2 purples (medium and dark)
  - 25cm blue and 35cm green for the repeat appliqué in the border rectangle blocks

Special note: You will not need all this appliqué fabric!! Heaven forbid you will need a bank loan! Just look carefully at the quilt and see which bits need more or bring your favourite scraps!

If you want to use the same fabrics as my quilt they are nearly all fabrics from the Adelaide Collection (In the Beginning fabrics), so see if your local quilt shop can get them for you.



**Notions:**

- 2 metres of fusible appliqué paper (to get started)
- Threads: Beige or grey thread for your bobbin. Michele likes the *Bottom Line* but Rasant works well also.
- Machine embroidery threads to match appliqué (100% rayon recommended)
- Size 10 Schmetz microtex sharp sewing machine needles
- Sewing basket with usual notions, including a pair of small sharp pointed scissors for paper and scissors for fabric/thread
- Small plastic bags to keep pattern pieces in
- Pencil
- Notebook if you like to take notes (notes and patterns will also be provided)

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69 ½” square before quilting (176.5cm square)**

**Before the workshop you can precut your background blocks if desired.**

**You will need sixteen 13 ½” squares.**

**The sixteen border rectangles are 6 ½” x 13 ½” and the four corners 6 ½” square.**

Please note that you only need to bring the materials listed above and do not need purchase an additional kit for this class.

**Sewing machines** will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own.

A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual and accessories.

- Also **bring your open toed appliqué foot**. This is for machine appliqué – **NOT** the one for free motion machine quilting.

**Suggestions:**

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
