



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **FMQ: A Great Beginning**

Dates: **Thurs, April 12**

Classroom: **4**

You must bring along the following:

- 4 pieces of 50 x 70cm black, 100% cotton homespun fabric and 2 pieces of 50 x 70cm wool/ poly wadding pinned together with safety pins 3 inches apart to make 2 quilts.
- 2 pieces of black homespun and wadding 30 cm square pinned as above. This is for warm-up stitching at the beginning of the day.
- 1 reel of black 100 % cotton 50 weight thread for the bobbin.
- 2-6 reels of Mettler polysheen variegated or Cotton 50 wt and 40 wt cotton variegated thread.
- Small sharp scissors
- Quilt pounce with white powder if you have one
- Machine needles size 80 and 90 sharp or quilting
- 8 sheets of A4 paper
- Pencil
- Quilting gloves (eg. Ansell hi flex)

Kit fee: A kit is provided for this class at a cost of **\$5**.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your name and the tutor's and class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

Kit consists of:

- Notes to accompany the class.

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own.

A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual and accessories.

Also **bring your darning foot or equivalent and extension table**.

Suggestions:

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
