



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

You must bring along the following:

- General sewing requirements including scissors, rotary cutter, mat
 - Sewline Fabric Glue Pen (available on the day)
 - Sewline Trio Pencil (available on the day)
 - Busyfingers template paper (available on the day)
 - *Busyfingers Size 11 milliners needles (available on the day)
 - Busyfingers Appliqué Glue (available on the day)
 - Superior Bottom Line Thread
- *Sue recommends this brand but you may have generic ones that are suitable

**Fabric required for quilt (see note below re Fabric Kit Option):

- 1.1m (1 ¼ yards) background fabric for large appliqué blocks
- 1.1m (1 ¼ yards) medium sized red print fabric for reverse appliqué on large appliqué blocks
- 2m (2 ¼ yards) red tone on tone border fabric (includes binding) (Note: the red needs to be the same tone as the medium sized red print fabric on the large appliqué blocks)
- 2 7" (20cm) strips across width of fabric of 6 assorted light background fabrics for small blocks
- 32 7" (20cm) x 21" strips of assorted fabrics for small blocks
- Extra assorted small pieces of fabric for English paper piecing and appliqué blocks
- 2 8" squares assorted fabrics for large pieced blocks (Note: if you want to fussy cut these fabrics, you will need to make sure you have enough fabric to cut 6 pieces on the same pattern repeat)

Kit fee: A kit is provided for this class at a cost of **\$70** (required). There is also a second, optional kit available at an additional cost of **\$60**.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your name and the tutor's and class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

Kit consists of:

- Pattern, including pre-cut papers and acrylic templates, (required by all students)
- **The **optional kit** also contains a fabric starter pack (total of 2.7m fabric including background fabric, reverse appliqué fabric and assorted fabrics for English paper piecing and appliqué)

Suggestions:

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
