



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **Pemberley**

Dates: **Thurs/Fri, April 12-13**

Tutor: **Katrina Hadjimichael**

Classroom: **12**

You must bring along the following:

The quilt features a “fussy-cut” flower in the scallop border around the centre oval and in the Dresden blocks in the outer border. 52 flowers (approx. 1¼” in diameter) are required so the amount of fabric will vary. This piece is required for class.

The tutor started with this fabric and took the colours for the rest of the appliqué from it: blue, maroon, pink, green, gold and brown.

The following are required for the class:

- 4m light caramel with cream leaves for background to centre oval and background to all outside blocks (only 80cm is required for class: precut one 14” x 20” rectangle and (four) 10” squares from this piece and bring to class)
- 1m light cream with tiny light brown flower for background to centre appliqué rectangle (this should be lighter in value than the first background fabric listed)
- A wide range of fabrics in reproduction colours and prints for fussy-cutting and appliqué are required, although small pieces (eg. fat eighths) can be brought to class.
- 60cm green (or other colour) for vines
- Fat quarter fabric for piping around centre oval medallion (eg. maroon – contrasting with colours in scallop fabric)
- 60cm blue tone on tone for background to wavy appliqué border (precut into (four) strips 5” wide across the width of the fabric)
- 30cm cream with small flower (Wavy appliqué shape to be appliquéd on top of blue border)

Notions required in class (hand appliqué supplies):

- Small rotary cutting mat, 28mm cutter and 6½” x 12” ruler
- Short appliqué pins
- Fine needles such as size 12 sharps
- Threads to match appliqué fabrics: such as Mettler fine embroidery No 60 or silk
- Thimble of your choice
- Paper scissors
- Sticky tape
- Small sharp embroidery/fabric scissors
- 2B pencil and sharpener
- Several A3 sheets of cartridge weight paper (110gsm) available from newsagents
- Clover brand ¼” bias tape maker
- Best Press spray starch (or Crisp spray starch)
- 30cm fusible webbing such as Vliesofix (or pre-cut roll of fusible web for ¼” tape maker) to attach vines in position or if you prefer water soluble fabric glue such as Roxanne’s glue.
- All borders are sewn on the machine after class.

Not required for class:

- 1.6m light brown tea stain for background to Dresden plate border
- 2.8m maroon flower stripe for final border. If using a border print, this is cut down the length of the fabric and you will need 2.8m. If cutting fabric across the width and joining it for the borders, you will need 1.5m.
- Additional assortment of fabrics for appliqué.
- 80cm binding fabric

Kit fee: A kit is provided for this class at a cost of **\$105**.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your name and the tutor's and class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

Kit consists of:

- 18 typed pages, including twelve A3 pattern sheets and colour photographs in a plastic folder.
- Kit of laser cut paper templates and Perspex "peeper" fussy cutting templates includes:
 - (150) ½" hexagons with peeper
 - (40) 1" jewels with peeper
 - (75) ⅝" circles
 - (350) short dresdens with peeper
 - (64+) long dresdens blades with peeper
 - (100) KH curved pentagons with peeper
 - (100) KH pointed pentagons with peeper
 - (20) 2½" circles

Suggestions:

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
