



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **The Patterned Landscape**

Dates: **Thurs/Fri, April 12-13**

You must bring along the following:

- Pen, Pencil (2B), eraser, sticky tape, black medium felt-tipped marker
- Large sheet of white paper – needs to be at least as big as proposed quilt size (can be joined)
- Pins – straight pins and 40 safety pins (for sandwiching quilt)
- ¼ metre of non-iron, tear-away (available from the tutor for \$6 metre)
- 1 metre of Steam a Seam 2 Lite (24 inches wide available from the tutor for \$24 metre)
- 1 metre of Fusible webbing such as Vliesofix, Wonder under
- Thread to match tree fabric (eg. black)
- Embroidery threads – for free machine embroidery and decorative appliqué (colours to match and contrast with background shapes)
- Topstitch machine needles size 80 and 90
- Fabric scissors, small sharp scissors, paper scissors, quick unpick/ seam ripper.
- Circle and/or diamond templates if you have them (tutor will have some in class for you to use)
- Rotary cutter, ruler and small cutting mat if using squares or diamonds as background shapes.
- Batting** – ideally thin batting such as cotton, bamboo, Pellon etc – one metre square should be sufficient
- Fabrics** (some suitable hand-dyed fabrics available for sale from the tutor)
- One metre of fabric for the background.
- One metre of fabric for the tree – suggest a dark colour
- Lots of smaller pieces of fabric for the decorations, including fabrics that have a variation in pattern and value. A suggestion is to choose two or three colours that work well together and contrast well with the background colour.
- One metre of fabric for the backing.

Note – as each student will be making their own unique project some may use less fabric and there may be some requirements that are not used. Please note that there is no kit provided for this class but tear-away, Steam a Seam and suitable hand-dyed fabrics are available from the tutor as an option.

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own.

A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Also **bring your darning foot**, an open toed embroidery foot and walking foot.

Suggestions:

- Please make sure you label everything with your name.
- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height.
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated.
- Don't forget to bring your glasses.
