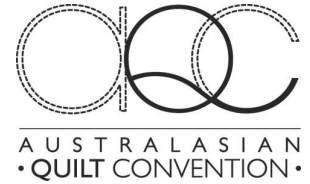

The Lut-Da Award for quilters, who have made an outstanding contribution to their community through quilting, presented by Expertise Events.

This award will acknowledge an individual who has made outstanding contribution to their community through quilting. Their work may have been to assist individuals or groups in need, or to develop programs to assist the general community, and must have utilised the medium of quilting. This award will recognise an individual who has worked for their community, via the medium of quilting. It is called Lut-Da after the aboriginal word meaning "to give".

Lut-Da Award JUDGING CRITERIA

Nominations should include:

1. Describe the work/ programs/ projects for the community that have been carried out by the nominee with specific details of the nominee's role.
2. Describe the impact/ effects of the work done.
3. Include letters/ statements/ references and any other relevant material to support your nomination.

Notes on Nomination for awards

- Previously nominated persons who were not award recipients may be nominated again. (To be nominated is in itself an achievement and these awards seek to recognise achievements over a period of time, particularly the Rajah Award.)
- These awards are not a state competition. They are national awards – we are asking you to look at the national picture; nominated persons do not have to come from your own state.
- Judging will be made based on nominations received. Requested items such as information, pictures etc are all part of the nomination.
