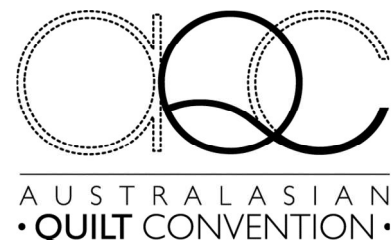


CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: **Exploring Appliqué**

Tutor: **Eileen Campbell**



You must bring along the following:

- Calico or plain Homespun to attach samples to and for spraying etc, enough for at least 6-8 pieces A4 size.
- Pieces of fabric (about 5 X 7 inches suitable for appliqués, flowers, leaves, creatures etc.
- ½ m Vliesofix or other paper backed fusible webbing.
- ¼ m Iron-on Vilene.
- Low loft batting (can be cotton, poly or wool) about A4 size.
- Solvy (wash-away stabiliser).
- Threads – Number 40 machine embroidery rayons are best, in various colours. Yellow, red, green, blue and brown would cover most things.
- Polyester thread for the bobbin, or bobbinfil if you normally use it.
- Monofilament thread if you have it (don't buy it specially).
- Hoop suitable for a machine. A 7 inch plastic and metal spring hoop is excellent.
- Sewing machine in good working order, with Instruction Manual.
- Size 80 machine needles.
- Size 80 (or 75) metallic or topstitch needles.
- Spare bobbins.
- Approximately 1m of baking paper (silicon paper).
- Small sharp pointed scissors for paper and fabric.
- Pencil, pen and notebook.

- Kit fee:** A kit is provided for this class at a cost of \$20.
 - ✓ Includes Iron-on Tearaway.
 - ✓ Heat-away (Thermogaze).
 - ✓ Metallic foil.
 - ✓ Angelina fibre.
 - ✓ Gossamer fuse OR Misty fuse.
 - ✓ Tassel template.
 - ✓ Patterns.
 - ✓ Quilting design.

Sprays, stencils, crayons etc are not in the kit but will be provided to share.

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount required and place it in an envelope with your name and the tutor's name on the front. This is to be given to the tutor before commencement of the class.

Sewing Machine: Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available in class to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may. Ensure it is well maintained and that you also bring the instruction manual and accessories, and bring your applique or open-toed embroidery foot and darning foot.

We also recommend bringing along a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height. This is not a necessity, just suggested.

Please make sure you label everything with your name.
